IMPORTANT – READ ALL DETAILS CAREFULLY!!

Step 1	Pay your fee at the San Juan College Business Office. The cost is \$25 for on-campus testing.
Step 2	Call the SJC Testing Center at 566-3139 or 566-3329 for an appointment. Receipt numbers will be required in order to schedule your appointment. You must schedule your appointment at least a full business day prior to the test date.
Step 3	Be sure to show up for your appointment or call to reschedule at least 24 hours in advance or you will be charged a \$10 no-show fee.

Details:

- You will have a maximum of three hours to take this computerized exam.
- You must bring two forms of ID with you to take the test. One must be a government issued photo ID.
- The SJC Testing Center is located in room 7120 of the Information Technology Building.
- **You must set up your exam by July 15, 2009.**
- **Testing must be completed by July 31, 2009.**
- You may retest after 30 days.
- For more information about the exam, go to www.psbtests.com and look at the Health Occupations Entrance Exam. There is no official study guide.
- You will be expected to follow the rules listed in this flyer.

Rules for use of the SJC Testing Center

1. The SJC Testing Center hours are 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday. Saturday hours are from 8:30 AM until 3:30 PM. **Testing times for the HOAE are 8:30 AM or 12:30 PM weekdays, and 8:30 AM or 12:00 PM on Saturdays.** We are closed on Saturdays in the month of July.
2. You must show **Government issued photo I.D.** before being given any test. Your driver's license, passport or other government issued **photo I.D.** are acceptable forms. For TEAS testing, a second ID is also required.
3. Purses, books and backpacks must be stowed in one of our lockers along with the items listed below. **Cell phones and other electronic devices are not permitted in the testing rooms;** this includes portable stereos, MP3 players, radios, or headphones. Cameras are not allowed.
4. Food, candy, gum and beverages are not allowed in the testing room. Hats, **hoodies** and digital watches are not allowed in the testing room.
5. Please be aware that if you smoke or wear excessive perfume, cologne, or other strong smelling lotions/sprays on the day of your test, you could be asked to reschedule your exam.
6. If you need special accommodations due to a disability or medical condition, they must be arranged in advance with the Director of Testing and the Students with Disabilities Office. Appropriate documentation will be required.
7. Everything you need for the actual test will be provided. You will not be allowed to take any materials into the testing room.
8. Only people who are taking a test are allowed in our testing room or waiting areas. The SJC Testing Center staff cannot be responsible for children or adults who require care and supervision.
