Early Admission Guidelines and Expectations

Early Admission students are held to the same policies and procedures as all non-degree seeking students at San Juan College. Understanding the guidelines and expectations below is vital to your success. Please read through them carefully.

- As an Early Admission student you are **not** eligible to enroll in classes at the Health and Human Performance Center.
- Any changes to your college schedule, including adding or dropping classes **must be approved and processed by the Coordinator of Enrollment Services.**
- You do **not** have access to the Online Registration system. You **do** have access to ANGEL our online program. You can also access your grades; print off a schedule or an unofficial transcript through MySJC Portal. If you need to login to ANGEL or MySJC Portal, you will need a username and password. Your default username and password are:
Username: First initial, middle initial, last name, and the last two digits of your social
Password: "sjcp" then the last four digits of your social
If you have issues logging in please contact the Help Desk at 505-566-3266
- You are responsible for paying all tuition, fees, and books by the appropriate deadline as stated in the schedule. Please be aware that you will **not** be sent a bill.
- If your cumulative GPA falls below a 2.0 you will be placed on academic probation. Students enrolled for a semester on probation are suspended when both the semester GPA and cumulative GPA are below 2.0.
- The grades you receive on your College transcript will affect your permanent College GPA and could affect future scholarship and admission opportunities. Therefore if you are having difficulty in your college classes, contact the Coordinator of Enrollment Services immediately 505-566-3532.
- As long as you remain in good academic standing and abide by the guidelines outlined above, you are invited to continue as an Early Admission Student until you graduate from high school.
