

San Juan College Early Admission Process

Early Admission is for high school **Juniors or Seniors** who are currently enrolled in high school at least half time and who have established residency within the four corners and who wish to take college classes while they are still in high school. College classes taken under early admission count only for college credits and will **not** count toward high school credits. Early admit students are admitted as non-degree seeking students. Non-degree admission status students **ARE NOT** eligible for any financial aid.

All requests for early admission must be made directly to the Coordinator of Enrollment Services. The requirements for early admission are outlined below:

- Submit a completed SJC application for admission. Online submission is FREE, Paper submission \$10 fee
- Successfully complete the Accuplacer evaluation when registering for courses with English, Reading, and/or Math prerequisites, *with* recommendations into college level classes (English 111, Reading 113 and Math 115). Contact the Advising and Counseling Center for testing information 566-3526. **Note: the Accuplacer evaluation can be waived (for a specific area) if the student applying has an ACT composite score at or above the 80th percentile of the national norms in that area. Must meet all course prerequisites whether or not Accuplacer is required.**
- Have a meeting with the Coordinator of Enrollment Services once Accuplacer is complete (by appointment only)
- Submit a copy of high school transcript of work through previous semester
- Obtain written parental/guardian permission to enroll at SJC
- Submit a completed *Early Admission Registration Form* (each semester)

A review of the students file will be conducted once all the documents listed above are submitted and a decision will be made regarding the student's eligibility for early admission. Please note: a student with an incomplete file cannot be accepted.

- **Eligible Coursework**

Early Admit students may take any course (including online courses) with the exception of classes for audit, developmental, physical education courses or private instruction applied music courses. Early admission status is allowed during each term including Spring, Summer, and Fall.

- **Early Admission-Home Schooled Students**

Special provision has been made to allow qualified home schooled students to attend San Juan College as early admit students. For specific information concerning home schooled admission, contact the Admissions Specialist.
