* For Early Admission and Dual Credit, Students must have a minimum high school grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 for English, Mathematics, and Science, or a 2.0 for all other discipline/courses.

NOTE: If a student fails to withdraw from dual credit classes that were intending to use to substitute for a high school requirement they will have to make up those credits in order to graduate; the dual credit course grade will appear on the student high school transcript; (as per New Mexico Higher Education Department Dual Credit Administrative Rules 5.55.4.8H.14 NMAC).
