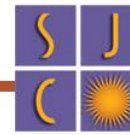
- Resources, encouragement and role models that help you explore and plan for health care programs, starting with health care prerequisite courses such as biology, chemistry and math

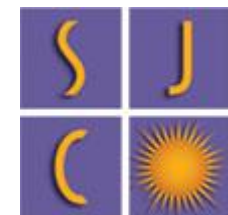
