



## MLA Documentation for Online Resources

---

### Web Site

It is necessary to list your date of access because web postings are often updated, and information available at one date may no longer be available later. Be sure to include the complete address for the site. Also, note the use of angled brackets around the electronic address; MLA requires them for clarity.

Author(s). Name of Page. Date of Posting/Revision. Name of institution/organization affiliated with the site.  
Date of Access <electronic address>.

Example: Felluga, Dino. Undergraduate Guide to Literary Theory. 17 Dec. 1999. Purdue University.

### Online Subscription Database Service (Info Trac, First Search, Newsbank, etc.)

The citation elements to be included, if available, for work from a subscription service are in the following order:

- Author (last name first)
- Article Title (in quotation marks)
- Publication Name (underlined or italicized)
- Publication Date
- Page Number/Range
- Database Name (underlined)
- Service Name (InfoTrac, First Search, Newsbank, etc.)
- Name of the library where service was accessed
- Name of the town/city where service was accessed

- Date of Access (when you found the information – no period)
- URL of the service (followed by a period)

Author's name (if given). "Title of Article." Name of Magazine Date of Publication: Pages. Name of Database. Service Name. Library Name. Date of Access <[http://infotrac.galegroup.com/itweb/hawaii\\_honolulu](http://infotrac.galegroup.com/itweb/hawaii_honolulu)>.
