The Cosmetology program is designed to meet the standards established by the New Mexico State Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists. The program covers coursework in the theory and lab in sterilization, shampoo, rinses, hairstyling, pedicuring, salon business and retail sales, in addition to college general education courses. The program meets the minimum of 1,600 clock hours required by the State Board. Students may choose to attend full-time or part-time. After successfully completing the program, students are qualified to take the New Mexico Board of Cosmetology licensure examination. Licensing and certification for immediate employment in the field are obtained by passing this examination. Students entering this program are required to complete appropriate basic skills classes as determined by the scores on the College's entrance exam. This is a selective admission program that admits students in the fall and spring terms.
