The Associate of Applied Science degree in Tribal Governance is a specialized program of study for any student who wishes to work within the tribal government system. Students are encouraged to sign up for some of the courses in order to better understand the internal workings of a Native American governance structure. The program covers coursework in history, organizational behavior, administrative law and leadership within the tribal government structure. This degree is not intended for transfer to a 4-year college or university. Students are encouraged to meet with the program coordinator to discuss their career goals prior to enrolling in the program.
