Students interested in a career in the Building Trades have four options: the Associate of Applied Science Degree, Framing Certificate, Insulation and Drywall Certificate, and the Finish Carpentry Certificate. The Associate of Applied Science Degree is the most comprehensive program and includes all certificate training areas. Students will participate in the construction of a home beginning with the design phase through the finished product. Their level of training will be dependent on which training program they choose.

- This program requires that the student purchase his/her own tools. To obtain a list of required tools, contact the program instructor, 566-3336.
- Students must earn a grade of "C" or higher in all courses in order to receive a degree or certificate.
