Note: This program requires that the student purchase his/her own tools. To obtain a list of the required tools, contact the Automotive Department. A student must earn a grade of a "C" or higher in all courses in order to receive a degree. All courses are designed for 8 week period. If the program starts in an odd numbered year, the first Co-op will be in the first semester. If the program starts in an even numbered year, the first Co-op will be in the second semester.
