POLICY TOPIC: Admissions

I. Admissions

San Juan College is an independent two-year comprehensive community college having as a major part of its fundamental mission, the provision of serving the need and making accessible postsecondary education to the members of the community. In order to fulfill this mission, the College has an open door policy for admission of students in credit courses and programs who have graduated from an accredited high school, completed a General Education Development (GED) certificate, or who, through age and experience, qualify for admission, as well as opportunities for high school juniors and seniors. San Juan College noncredit course admission shall be in accordance with program procedures and admission policies as described herein.

II. Admission Requirements

General admission requirements and specific course and program admission requirements are outlined in the College Catalog and Student Handbook. All admission procedures shall be under the direct supervision of the Director of Admissions and Records and Enrollment Services and subject to review and action by the Vice President for Student Services.

III. Equal Access

San Juan College is committed to equal access to all students who make use of College programs and services. Students are considered for admission without regard to sex, race, color, religion, creed, national origin, age, or disability.

IV. Admissions Appeal

If an applicant feels that he/she has been unjustly denied admission to the College, he/she shall follow an appeals process as outlined in the Student Handbook.
