The School of Science is comprised of two departments: The Department of Natural Sciences offers Associate of Science degrees in Biology, Chemistry, Engineering, General Science, Geology, Geography, Physics and Pre-Medical Sciences and an Associate of Applied Science degree in Horticulture. In addition to the associate degrees there are one-year certificates available in Geographic Information Systems and Horticulture. The Department of Mathematics offers an Associate of Science degree with a concentration in the field of mathematics. Courses range from developmental to upper level classes such as linear algebra and differential equations. The department supports the mathematics requirements in other degrees offered at San Juan College such as health, energy, engineering, and computer science. Science and math courses

taken at San Juan College provide a strong background for students interested in transferring to a four-year program to complete a bachelor's degree in the sciences or mathematics.

The School of Trades and Technology offers 12 full time programs with options of a two-year Associate of Applied Science degree or a one-year certificate. Each program gives students the opportunity to apply skills learned from the classroom/lab/shop to the work environment.
