- Procedures for Admission to San Juan College**
1. Submit your Application for Admission to San Juan College online or at Main Campus. Allow 5 – 7 days for processing before taking Accuplacer tests.
 2. Apply for financial aid, if needed, at the Main Campus or online at www.fafsa.edu.gov.
 3. Complete the Accuplacer tests, consult with the Advising & Counseling Center and an Academic Advisor for help in enrolling in General Education classes.

- Procedures for Acceptance in LSOP Program**
1. Contact the School of Energy for a Program Application. The deadline for returning the application is **May 15 by 5:00 pm**.
 2. You will be notified via mail if you have/have not been selected for an interview. You will also be notified by mail if you have/have not been accepted into the program.
 3. Background check is conducted prior to an interview. Drug and alcohol testing may be conducted by random selection or at any time with probable cause.
