

# IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT TUITION AND FEES

## Dear Student,

This letter is to inform you about the changes in tuition and fees at San Juan College, beginning with the summer 2009 semester. **For resident students, tuition has been increased by \$2 a credit hour, to \$32. Non-resident students will now pay \$70 per credit hour.**

Compared to other colleges and universities in the state and nationally, tuition at San Juan College remains extremely affordable. Financial aid packages have been adjusted to absorb the changes. And, the value of your education is, of course, priceless.

In addition, some of you may be affected by new or increased fees in programs in which there are substantial costs of materials or equipment.
