SECTION: Campus Activities and Security

POLICY TOPIC: Beer and Wine Sales and Service at Specific Events

---

I. Use and Possession of Alcoholic Beverages on Campus

The purchase, possession, and consumption of alcoholic beverage on San Juan College Campus is prohibited except as specifically authorized by this policy.

II. Beer and Wine Sales and Service on San Juan College Campus

The College may permit the sales and service of beer and wine on campus so long as the purchase, possession, service, and consumption of beer and wine is done in accordance with all applicable federal and state law, rules, and regulations.

III. Authorized Events

Beer and wine may be served or sold at special events held on Campus upon prior written approval of the Vice President for Administrative Services. Any request to serve beer or wine on campus must be made thirty (30) days in advance of the event. The College President or Vice President for Administrative may limit beer and wine service or sales to specific facilities on Campus and place restrictions on the event as deemed necessary. Beer and Wine service or sales may only be done by a licensed vendor approved by San Juan College. No outside alcoholic beverages will be permitted on Campus. The College may require an organizer of an event to provide liquor liability insurance in an amount required by the College.

IV. Relation to Other College Policies

All faculty, staff, and employees of San Juan College must comply with College policy and associated rules that prohibit the possession and use of alcohol on the job. Further, nothing in this policy permits the unlawful sale, possession, or consumption of alcoholic beverages on College property or at College events.
