- Class of 2022

- Participated in Kiddie Clinic. The senior class has turned this into a Student American Dental Hygienists' Association (SADHA) fundraiser.
- Working on their Service Learning Honors requirements. The students have an opportunity to present their Table Clinic topics at a Student Research Conference in December.

 Clinic, Life Care, Head Start, Presbyterian Medical Services, and local Dental observations.
- Will be taking their Local Anesthesia Boards soon, their Clinical Boards in April, and their National Board Dental Hygiene Exams in May.
