Section G – Admission Test for Dental Hygiene (ATDH)

• ATDH Information

- Read the complete <u>ATDH Candidate Guide</u> before submitting your ATDH application. The Candidate Guide can be found at https://www.ada.org/education/testing/exams/admission-test-for-dental-hygiene-atdh. This guide provides important information about application and testing procedures, examination content, fees, etc.
- Start by obtaining a new <u>DENTPIN</u>. Your DENTPIN is the unique identifier for all your dental testing needs.
- Complete the ATDH application and schedule an exam at one of the ATDH Test Centers.
 Students will need to submit their application 2 to 3 months before they intend to take the exam.
- o Students will need to send their ATDH scores directly to the San Juan College Registration and Records Department at records@sanjuancollege.edu.
- Students will need to include a copy of their ATDH scores with their Dental Hygiene Program Application.
- The San Juan College Testing Center will administer the ATDH on Fridays and Saturdays along with some Thursdays, except for the SJC holidays and graduation.
- o The ATDH will be available year-round, effective September 1, 2023.



Section H – ACT & SAT Exam Information

• ACT College Entrance Exams

- The San Juan College Testing Center will administer the ACT exam October 28, 2023 and December 9, 2023.
- Students will need to create an account at <u>www.act.org</u> to schedule a test and pay for the exam. In addition, the website contains helpful information about scoring, how to request score reports, and study guides.
- o Students will need to take the ACT (No Writing).
- Students will need to send their ACT scores directly to the San Juan College Registration and Records Department and include a copy with their Dental Hygiene Application. ACT scores can be sent to <u>records@sanjuancollege.edu</u>.
- o The San Juan College Center Code is 026370.

SAT College Entrance Exams

- The San Juan College Testing Center will administer the SAT exam on October 7, 2023 and November 4, 2023.
- Students will need to create an account at <u>www.sat.collegeboard.com</u> for detailed information regarding payments, dates, study guides, and registration information.
- o Students will need to take the Reading Test, Writing and Language Test, and the Math Test.
- Students will need to send their SAT Scores directly to the San Juan College Registration and Records Department and include a copy with their Dental Hygiene Application. SAT scores can be sent to records@sanjuancollege.edu.
- o The San Juan College Center Code is 32011.

NOTE: Registration deadlines are typically one month prior to the test dates.
